In 1989, our clubhouse was built at our new and current home at Hi Vista Park, Mount Louisa ready for the 1990 season.

Our club is run by dedicated volunteers who keep the wheels turning in one of the biggest Football Clubs in Townsville.

In 2024 we had 49 Junior teams and 7 Senior teams. 2024 was another great year for our Club with all Senior Teams in the finals and all our FQPL teams taking out the Grand Finals!

2024 also saw our club achieving its first FQ club rating status as a Development Committed Club, ranking at the top for regional Queensland.

2025 will also see our launch our Brothers Football Academy, headed by Director of Football, Jeremy Brockie. Jeremy brings a wealth of knowledge and experience with his extensive international playing career, including FIFA World Cup, Confederation Cup and Olympics.

Juniors Information Pack Registration and fees

Registrations will still be done in Squadi for 2025, however, on the final step you will be directed to the LetsPlayFootball webpage to register an account to pay the Football Australia component.

The 2025 registration process in Queensland requires players, coaches, and referees to follow the same initial process via Squadi, where you can purchase your relevant club product or participant package before completing Football Australia's simple, mandated registration process within the new LetsPlayFootball system, which also requires the payment of Football Australia's National Registration Fee where applicable.

Once you have completed the initial Squadi steps, a pop-up will appear providing a link directly to LetsPlayFootball where you can complete your registration and pay FA's National Registration Fee. A reminder of the process is outlined below:

2025 Registration Process:

- 1. Complete the registration process in Squadi
- 2. Select the club product in Squadi
- 3. Complete payment in Squadi (covers club and FQ governing body fees)
- 4. Follow the mandatory prompt to LetsPlayFootball registration page
- 5. Complete payment of FA's National Registration Fee in LetsPlayFootball

Please note: Players must be made active in both LetsPlayFootball (through payment of the National Registration Fee) and in Squadi to appear on teamsheets and be eligible to participate in any fixtures.




Juniors Information Pack Training Information

Training days and times are determined by the Coaches availability and also the availability of fields.

Juniors Information Pack Game Day Information

All junior games are held at the Paradise Park, Murray Sporting Complex – Annandale.

Football Queensland Northern commence the season in March. Please be mindful that due to this time of year, some games can be cancelled due to wet weather.

Season games for Juniors are held on Saturdays, morning and afternoon. Some age groups, may be required to travel to Ingham, Burdekin, Charters Towers or Bowen. We are unable to provide specific times until all clubs have provided team details for FQN to build a draw.

Team Managers and Coaches will receive copies of the rules. We encourage this to be shared with all parents and players to confirm understanding.

Playing shirts are issued to the Manager for team use throughout the season. Playing shirts are to be kept together and not to be issued to players to take home each week.

Players are to wear Brothers shorts and socks at each game. When playing another Brothers team, the away team will wear their training shirts.

Shin pads **must** be worn in each game. Peak caps, watches, necklaces and any other jewellery cannot be worn during games.

As all our players, Managers, Coaches, parents and families represent Brothers TSV FC during games, unruly behaviour at games cannot be tolerated. We encourage parents to cheer and support but please do not 'coach' from the sideline as this causes confusion to players and undermines the coach.

FQN have a gate entry fee to enter the complex grounds for all adults who do not hold an Official lanyard. Players and children are free. Volunteers man the entry points and are quite often abused by parents who feel they should be exempt from paying. These parents are reported back to the Club for action so we hope this don't occur from any of our families. Don't forget Coaches and Managers receive a lanyard for free entry!

Season passes are available from FQN or if you volunteer for FQN/Brothers, you will also receive a lanyard to obtain free entry.
